Additional Notes:

- **E-Filer:** A state committee that has received contributions or made expenditures totaling \$25,000 or more.
- Form 460: All state committees, including e-filers, must file paper reports with the Secretary of State. A copy must also be e-mailed to CalPERS at Board Election Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov.
- Form 460: Candidates who have raised/spent \$2,000 or more file the Form 460. The Form 410 (Statement of Organization) must also be filed once \$2,000 or more has been raised/spent.
- Form 470: Candidates who do not have an open committee and do not raise or spend \$2,000 may file Form 470 on or before August 29, 2018. If, later during the calendar year, a campaign committee must be opened, a Form 470 Supplement and a Form 410 must be filed.
- Forms 496 and 497: All reports filed online only with the Secretary of State and e-mailed to CalPERS at <u>Board_Election_Coordinator@calpers.ca.gov</u>.
- Multiple Candidate Controlled Committees: All committees controlled by a CalPERS candidate must file statements on each filing deadline, in addition to the committee formed for this election.
- Filing Deadlines: Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour independent expenditure reports (Form 496) or to 24-hour contribution reports (Form 497) that are due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. A \$10 per day late fine may be assessed on both the paper and electronic report resulting in a \$20 per day fine.
- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Contribution Limits:** Contributions to CalPERS candidates are subject to contribution limits of \$4,400 per election. Committees that make contributions to CalPERS candidates are subject to contribution limits of \$7,300 per calendar year.
- Public Documents: All forms are public documents. Campaign manuals and instructional materials available at <u>www.fppc.ca.gov</u>, click on the <u>Campaign</u> <u>Rules</u> link.
- Voting Periods: Begin August 31, 2018 and November 9, 2018.
- Section 84200.9 sets pre-election deadlines.
